Basecamp Cabin at Tributary: A Contemporary Mountain Home in the Tetons

Just over the hill from Jackson Hole, the Basecamp Cabin at Tributary captures the balance between mountain living and modern comfort. Located at 1240 Spotted Fawn in Driggs, Idaho, the 5,000-square-foot home is listed for \$6.295 million.

Tributary spans 1,500 acres in the Teton Valley, a setting defined by open space, over 500 acres of protected fen-designated wetlands, and mountain views. Across the property, seven fishing ponds and a network of trails create a rhythm of activity that changes with the seasons. The result is a place where design, recreation, and landscape coexist rather than compete.

The Basecamp Cabin's design honors this approach. Five bedroom suites and 5.5 bathrooms provide flexibility for family or guests, while vaulted ceilings of reclaimed wood and hand-finished details establish a sense of place. The home includes three fireplaces and two wet bars, with gathering areas positioned to accommodate both quiet evenings and larger gatherings. A second-floor bonus room offers additional space for work or recreation, and a heated three-car garage adapts easily to mountain life.

Throughout the interiors, materials were chosen as much for durability as for aesthetic effect. Quartzite countertops and engineered hardwood flooring balance refinement with practicality, while Wolf and Sub-Zero appliances ensure the kitchen performs to modern expectations. Large Marvin windows draw light into every room and frame views of the surrounding landscape.

Outdoor living is central to the home's character. A broad deck with a gas fire pit provides a natural extension of the interior—an ideal setting for watching sunsets, gathering after a day on the slopes, or simply taking in the quiet.

Homeownership at Tributary includes access to the community's full range of amenities. The recently renovated 18-hole golf course designed by David McLay Kidd anchors the property, joined by a wellness center, clubhouse, pool, and hot tub. Trails for skiing, a snowmobile track, and an ice rink keep winters active, while fishing ponds, a boardwalk, and an archery range define the warmer months. Members also have access to a private ski lounge at Grand Targhee Resort, roughly 25 minutes away.
